- ✓ Pause before signing any documents. Take time to review your termination letter and release.
- ✓ Gather your employment records offer letter, pay stubs, benefits information, and correspondence.
- ✓ Apply for Employment Insurance (EI) as soon as possible.
- ✓ Keep notes on the meeting, including who was present and what was said.
- ✓ If your health was affected or you were on disability, get medical documentation.
- Do not post about your termination online.
- Contact Tim Louis & Company before accepting or rejecting any severance offer.
- Record your job search efforts (dates, applications, responses) to support any future claim.
- ✓ Ask questions about benefits continuation and accrued vacation pay.
